Rationale

End-stage lung disease is a complex clinical condition requiring an integrated approach across diagnosis, transplant candidate selection, surgical treatment, and post-transplant management. Its care depends on close collaboration among pulmonologists, radiologists, pathologists, thoracic surgeons, anesthesiologists, immunologists, and healthcare professionals.

This Winter School is designed for medical students, residents, PhD candidates, and young specialists who wish to acquire a comprehensive understanding of the diagnostic and therapeutic pathway of advanced pulmonary diseases. Particular attention will be devoted to pathology and pathology-related aspects, including explanted lung assessment, transplant complications, rejection, infection, iatrogenic lesions, and long-term graft monitoring.

Through interactive lectures, multidisciplinary discussions, and case-based sessions, participants will explore the full journey from advanced lung disease to transplantation and post-transplant follow-up. Real-life clinical and pathological cases will provide a practical framework for understanding how different specialties contribute to patient management.

Developed within the strategic partnership between the Università degli Studi di Padova and the Université de Lausanne, the School aims to promote international academic exchange and practical multidisciplinary training in end-stage lung disease and lung transplantation. By integrating clinical, radiological, pathological, surgical, immunological, and patient-centred perspectives, the programme provides a structured educational model for young professionals involved in the care of patients with advanced pulmonary diseases.
